Individuals may take hazardous waste to the Becker County Landfill or Transfer Station for disposal. There are two locations:

East Location (Osage): Located 1/2 mile West of Osage on Hwy 34 and 1/2 mile South on Co. Hwy 47 (Limited hours: call 218-573-3534)

Main Location (Detroit Lakes): Located 3 miles North of Detroit Lakes on Hwy 59 and 1/2 mile West on Co. Rd 144 (call 218-847-6382)
