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

Comments:

- I would want to now the cost of this before I answer. I do not want assessments.
- We are at the end of Red Top Road and we have not noticed this issue. I understand that other
 areas of Red Top Road may be affected and that is likely where the request came from. Unlike
 assessments we have had in Fargo were deemed necessary by the city (roads, lights, etc.), I am
 concerned that a personal request could be subjected to special assessment of everyone on the
 road. I will be looking into this from a legal standpoint. Thank you though for allowing input.
- We feel the amount of taxes that we paid should take care of things like this. Our place is far enough off the road we could get by without.
- Salt once every other year has worked well in the past.
- The amount to share the cost was not mentioned. The last time we were part of the investment was about \$60, I think for each resident.
- There should have been a cost figure we say "NO" to both questions because of this.
- This has been done in the past and really helped with the dust and preventing wash boarding.
 Really the all around condition of the road was better. We are in favor of looking at any
 suggestions that would make the road better. A road that is not rough is also better for a vehicle.
 You could even go so far and say that of all the dust that is created some of it will end up in the lake
 as fine sediment.

- Thank you, Barb and the Town Board for following this approach. I sincerely hope we set a favorable response. We will see where I am at with things around May 8.
- Stop using motorcycles and ATV's for racing on Red Top Road and we will not have so much dust.
