In the Spring of 2020 our road contracts were renewed and Thelen's Excavating won the bid for the road grading and plowing. This contract is in affect through 2023. In June we installed a culde-sac on Dolly's trail and 1343 yards of Class 5 gravel was put on the roads this past year. Our road tour will probably be in May and we do plan to put down more Class 5 this summer again. We will be working with the contractor to determine where this is needed.
