	and because of liability he won't use landowners driveways. In the winter he brings in a pickup with plow to remove the snow. There has been several meetings to discuss how to enlarge the cul de sac. There is a hill in the easement but a cistern is located there to drain water away from houses and would be a large expense to move that way. The road needs graveling but a plan needs to be determined so graveling effective. Barb reviewed history road maintenance over the last 6 years. Horseshoe is not a Class C road and landowners would have to bring the road up to standards for full Maintenance. Barb provided copies of the Township standards. Currently, as a minimum maintenance road is graded twice yearly and snow is plowed. The Township doesn't have plans, nor ever had plans, to vacate the road.  Tom Lorentzen said the on his side of the cul de sac easement it could be enlarged but it is a downhill slope that would need a lot of fill. It was agreed that property owners, Barb and Len Thelen will meet at the site to review and decide on an option and Thelens' will provide the Board with the estimate. Graveling the road will be done before cul de sac work.  Discussed putting Calcium Chloride on roads. Hubbard County does a good job and the roads hold up. Will follow up with them.
