Subdivision 2. Definitions.

- 1. Farm Unit –Agricultural land currently used for the sole purpose of raising livestock or cultivated crops.
- 2. Feedlot, Agricultural An enclosure for the feeding, breeding, raising or holding of livestock, poultry of less than 500 animal units, or mink and other fur bearing animals in less than fifteen hutches, or is incidental to a permitted farming operation which has enough land to produce the majority of feed to feed the animals and dispose of the manure (animal wastes).

SECTION 7. CONSERVATION DISTRICT PERMITTED USES AND DENSITIES

Subdivision 2. Agricultural.

- 1. Farm buildings and permitted accessory buildings along with agriculture land uses including agriculture feedlots as provided for in the Becker County Ordinance and/or Minnesota Pollution Control Agency, whichever is more restrictive, shall be allowed.
- 2. Agriculture feedlots shall be allowed on current farm units where established farming practices occurred.
- 3. No Commercial feedlots shall be allowed.
